Description of Course

This unit provides students with opportunities to develop foundational communication skills in a language of their choice while exploring the diversity of languages, cultures and perspectives across the world. Students build their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills, develop intercultural understanding through cultural comparisons and reflection, and use a range of digital language-learning platforms to support their learning. Through this unit, students strengthen their communication skills and develop an appreciation of the value of language learning in an increasingly interconnected world.

Learning Outcomes

- With a range of purposes and for audiences, discusses and expands on ideas, shaping meaning and providing substantiation
- Reads, views and comprehends a range of texts created to inform, influence and/or engage audiences
- Analyses representations of people, places, events and concepts, and how texts respond to contexts
- Creates written and multimodal texts, including literary texts, for a range of purposes and audiences, expressing and expanding ideas, shaping meaning and providing substantiation
